Coastal Future Conditions Workshop

Shore Conditions, Processes, Vulnerability and Adaptation

June 22-23, 2015 in Pacifica, California

Monday, June 22nd Morning Focus

Nearshore Processes Knowledge and Research

Recent research and findings, available data and research needs will be presented. Talks will address the shore, surfzone and near-offshore zones pertinent to coastal evolution in terms of bed conditions, geology, geomorphology and hydrodynamic processes.

Monday, June 22nd Afternoon Focus

Modeling to predict future conditions based on long-term changes and extreme events

Contemporary and emerging coastal response modeling in California will be presented. Talks will address coastal erosion and flooding for sandy, bluff-backed and estuary shores.

Tuesday, June 23rd Morning Focus

Coastal Management Challenges and Programs

Speakers will provide their Agency's perspectives on the challenges facing coastal communities, and resources available for local planning and engineering staff and the general population.

Tuesday, June 23rd Afternoon Focus

First Session: Vulnerability Assessments

Description of recent coastal hazard mapping and assessments of coastal asset vulnerability. Coastal hazards include flooding, wave induced flooding and erosion, and the effects of sea level rise to increase these hazards. Vulnerability assessments include evaluations of property, development, infrastructure, ecology and community damage risk associated with future shore conditions.

Second Session: Adaptation Planning

Description of the recent coastal zone adaptation plans and planning processes in response to coastal erosion, the effects of sea level rise and multi-objective management of coastal resources.
